The Office of Citizenship (OoC) within U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) is seeking subject matter experts to serve on grant review panels from April 25 to May 13, 2011. These subject matter experts will assist in the review of grant applications from organizations preparing Lawful Permanent Residents for citizenship. Familiarity with immigrant service programs in the areas of English as a Second Language, citizenship instruction, and naturalization preparation is required. At least two years experience as an ESL instructor or administrator is highly desirable. The grant review, including training, will be Web and telephone-based. Potential reviewers will be screened for conflict of interest and relevant experience. Non-federal grant reviewers may receive compensation.

All subject matter experts must participate in a mandatory half-day web-based training, currently planned during the week of April 11-15.
