## Senate WIA Draft Bill Organization

The Senate WIA draft bill has a different organization system than the 1998 bill.

Title I: This title is a **new Title I**. It is the overarching title that governs all the other titles.

- Core Services: Beginning on page 7 it defines core services as youth, adult and dislocated employment and training services, adult education, Wagner Peyser, and Rehabilitation Services
- Performance Measures: Beginning on page 130 it identifies the performance measures for ALL CORE SERVICES. <u>READ CAREFULLY</u>—here is the concern regarding creaming.
- Unified State Plan: Beginning on page 43 are the unified state plan provisions.
- The HELP committee's description of this title: "To support a comprehensive and coordinated workforce development system, Title I of the Workforce Investment Act of 2011 streamlines governance provisions such as boards and plans and establishes common performance indicators across the four core WIA programs."
- This title is <u>on our web site</u> along with my hurried table of contents at <u>www.ncsdae.org</u> under the "National Legislation" button on the right menu.

<u>Yet to be released titles</u> include the following which will be released in the next five days and we will put them up on the web site and notify you.

Title II: This title provides for the one stop delivery system, job training formula programs, and national programs—the 1998 Title I.

Title III: Adult Education (the 1998 Title II)

Title IV: Amendments to the Wagner-Peyser Act

Title V: Amendments to the Rehabilitation Act

Title VI: General Provisions

Art and the Policy Committee and the Executive Committee will be studying the titles and making recommendations to the HELP Committee.

We had a call from the Democratic staff leadership last night and we have a call with the Republican staff leadership at noon today. We are scheduled to meet with the entire staff next week.

Their plan is to seek input now, file the bill on the  $17^{th}$ , and mark it up in committee on the June  $29^{th}$ .
