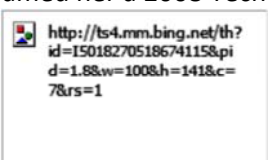
Keynote Speakers

Presentation Formats:

❖ Panel (60 minutes)

The proposal should describe the common theme/topic and the major points of discussion. The proposal should also describe how each panelist contributes a different perspective to the session. Please note if this panel could be repeated more than once.

❖ Workshare Presentation (60 minutes)

Workshare sessions provide an opportunity to share professional work products, effective practices, innovative applications, and creative solutions that are not ready to be presented as a paper. Perfect for Vendors! A proposal should include a description of the topic and/or product and its applicability to other institutions or programs. Please note if this presentation could be repeated more than once

❖ Workshops (60 minutes)

Workshops provide the opportunity for in-depth discussion and instruction on a single topic. Demonstrations, exercises, group activities, and other methods of experiential learning are appropriate and desirable. Proposals should outline the specific objectives of the workshop, the intended audience (novice or experienced researchers, prerequisite knowledge/skills, etc.), the instructional techniques, and the qualifications of the instructor(s). Please note if this workshop could be repeated more than once.
