Colleague Question: Guidance for Local PD Plans

Background: Patricia Terry and Vicki Anderson Prater (CA) write: California just opened up the WIA, Title II, AEFLA application for the first time in ten years. The Adult Education Office, California Department of Education is in the process of preparing notification letters for the applicant agencies. California adult education has always promoted professional development (PD) for our teachers and administrators, but sometimes the efforts and subsequent results are not as deliberate or robust as we'd like.

To that end, AEFLA grantees will be required to submit a professional development plan in the late summer or early fall. We have some idea of what we'd like to see at our local agencies, but we also don't want to reinvent the wheel.

REQUEST: We are hoping that states would share any agency level professional development plans, templates, or requirements they are currently using in their respective states as guidance for localities submitting local professional development plans.
