Juvenile Reentry Planning Grants

Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Planning Grants set up a state task force to improve juvenile reentry. If this is one of your interest areas, you may want to check in with our state JJDP colleagues.

Task Force “participants in the creation of the strategy should include representatives from public safety, corrections, housing (including partnerships with public housing authorities), health, **education**, substance abuse, children and families, victims’ services, employment, and business”

“Example outcomes include time to school re-enrollment and school attendance, employment, involvement in prosocial activities, substance use, and family involvement in the child welfare and other service systems.”
